Maths



This term we will be working hard on developing number sense and understanding place value. Children will also be working on securing solid methods for addition and subtraction and moving on to multiplication and division. Pupils will also tested weekly on times tables so get practising at home!

Geography



Pupils will be learning about the complex journey of our rivers from source to sea. They will learn how rivers change our landscape and investigate the rivers in our local area. Pupils will also learn about lines of latitude and longitude.

Science
