

Mathematics

Number: Place Value

Count forwards & backwards within 20/50
Tens and ones within 20/50
Compare numbers within 50
Count objects to 100 and read and write numbers in numerals and words
Represent numbers to 100
Tens and ones with a part-whole model
Tens and ones using addition

Use a place value chart
Compare and order objects and numbers
Count in 2s, 5s, 10s and 3s

Number-Addition and Subtraction

Addition and subtraction bonds to 20, 100
Check calculations
Compare number sentences
Related facts
Add and subtract 1s, 10s
10 more and 10 less
Add by making 10
Add a 2digit + 1digit number - crossing ten
Subtraction - crossing 10
Subtract a 1digit number from a 2digit number - crossing ten
Add two 2digit numbers - not crossing ten, crossing ten
Subtract a 2digit number from a 2digit number - not crossing ten, crossing ten
Add three 1digit numbers
