VISIT SOUTH AFRICA WITH US

Don't forget that **TODAY** (Thursday 13th Oct) you can join our lunchtime information drop in room 409 about our upcoming trip to South Africa.

Departing in July 2023, this will be an epic wildlife adventure which will expand your horizons and build your cultural capital. Places are open to all students regardless of study programme. This ten day trip will see you being involved in conservation in Africa and experiencing the stunning natural beauty of the Albizia Environmental Camp. You will also have a once in a lifetime opportunity to get up close to elephants and other amazing wildlife. The trip will depart 8th July 2023 and return on the 18/19th July, dependent upon return flights.

There will also be an opportunity to learn more about the culture of South Africa with a visit to a local primary school and a chance to visit a Zulu village to explore the role of women in traditional Zulu society and find out how this is changing. Students will have a chance to give back, for example by joining a beach clean up day. Dependent upon fundraising, there may also be a chance to meet and help dehorn a rhino.


Thank you for respecting that eating and drinking is not allowed in the LRC.
