- This is a quiet area for personal contemplation, reflection or prayer only - it is not an area for socialising
- Our staff will visit the Centre throughout the day
- If entering one of the contemplation rooms, you should cover your shoes with carpet protectors. These will be available by each entrance and can be disposed of on exit
- The Centre should be left tidy and hygienic at all times e.g. any equipment used during your visit should be stored away at the end of your visit
