We know that there are lots of practicalities with our remote learning approach and we are supporting our students every step of the way, as best we can. This news bites provides a number of updates which will support you during this time.

SHARING A COMPUTER OR HAVE LIMITED ACCESS?

Don't forget that there are apps that work on Android phones, tablets and iPhones so you can continue working using your device - see below for details of how you can download apps for free.

Once you have downloaded the apps, you can then use the phones/tablet built in dictation to write up text on the smaller screen:

- o Go into the notes app or one of the Apps above, bring up the keyboard by tapping where you want to type
- o Tap the microphone icon on your keyboard. start speaking to use voice dictation
- o Your device will insert the words as you speak them
- o Save and then share to Email or OneDrive to edit and use later on

Remember that you can get the Mobile version of Moodle on your phone too.

FREE MICROSOFT OFFICE AND ADOBE CREATIVE SUITE!

If you are finding that the Office365 versions of Word, PowerPoint or Excel don't have all the functions that you need, then remember you can download the full versions to your own devices for FREE. You can access 5 copies for your phone, tablet or home computer.

Connect to office365 via the student portal, then select 'My Account' and then select the Office Apps and Devices tab and follow the instructions to Install office.
