## IMPORTANT UPDATE REGARDING UCAS APPLICATIONS

Government has instructed all universities to stop changing or making unconditional offers until the picture becomes fully clear about how grades will be awarded. Whilst some of you will have had an amended or unconditional offer, it is important that you do not feel pressurised into accepting it. To support this, there are some new deadlines as follows:

- 19<sup>th</sup> May ( was 5<sup>th</sup> May) the deadline you have to respond to any offers you received by 31<sup>st</sup> March
- 20<sup>th</sup> May (was 6<sup>th</sup> May) the deadline universities have for applications received by 15<sup>th</sup> January
