In 2019 there were 15.5m non voters in the General Election - that's over 2m more people than those who gave their vote to the winning party, the Conservatives. If non voters had used their vote, the outcome would have potentially been hugely different!

Next week as part of the upcoming Parliament Week, Kirklees Democracy will be at HNC, inviting you to join the Electoral Register. You can do this now even if you are not yet old enough to vote, and it will ensure you are invited to vote as soon as you are eligible.
