



## **Introduction**

This policy statement sets out the College's arrangements for managing the access of providers to students at the College for the purpose of giving them information about the provider's education or training courses and opportunities.

This complies with the school's legal obligations under Section 42B of the Education Act 1997.

## **Student Entitlement**

Student in years 1 and 2 are entitled to: -

- Find out about technical education qualifications and apprenticeship opportunities as part of the careers programme, which provides information on the full range of education and training options available at the end of transition point Key Stage 5.
- Hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education and apprenticeships.
- Understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses.
