



## **Statement on the use of the 16-19 Tuition Fund - October 2020**

As required by the Education and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA) and detailed in their document '16 to 19 funding: 16 to 19 tuition fund', we are publishing this statement explaining how Huddersfield New College will use the funding that we have been allocated.

The additional funding will be used to provide personalised support through small group tuition, access to online learning platforms, smaller class sizes and additional pastoral support for eligible 16 to 19 students. This support will be focussed on those students who have not yet achieved a grade 4 in GCSE English and / or Maths.

The funding will be allocated to curriculum areas, prioritising English and Maths, to support small groups of students, typically 3 to 5, who have identified gaps in their knowledge, a need to improve in specific areas or need more time with subject specialists. The aim is to develop their key academic skills and improve their subject-specific knowledge and understanding to enable them to make good progress on their study programme. The funding will also be used to provide additional tutorial support to further enhance this cohort's personal development and progression opportunities to education or employment and to ensure their well-being during a period of sustained challenge.
