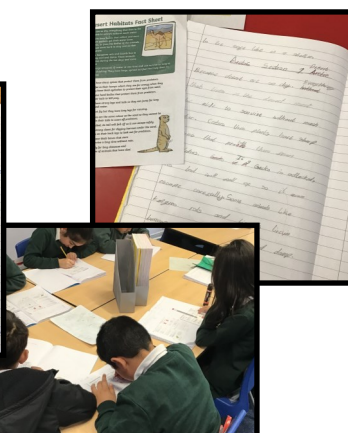
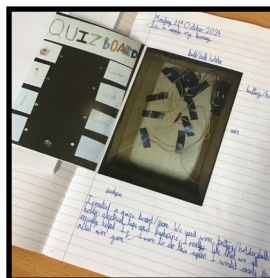
## Focus on Punctuality

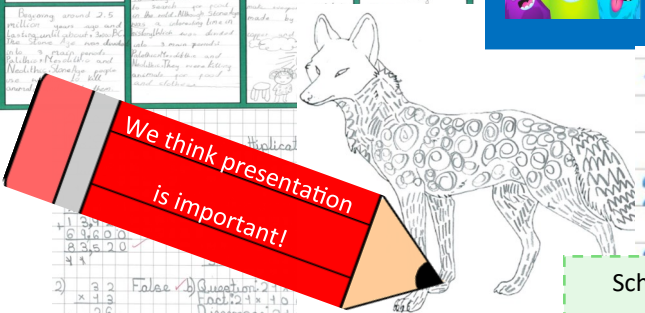
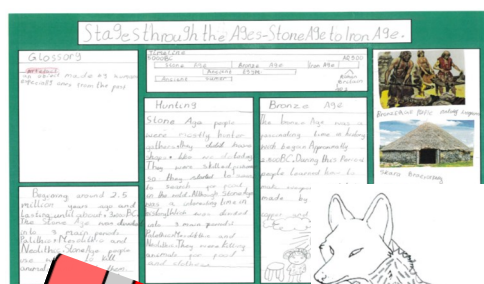

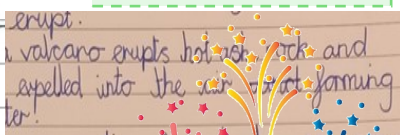
