Thank you again for all your support—it truly makes a difference. Have a great weekend!

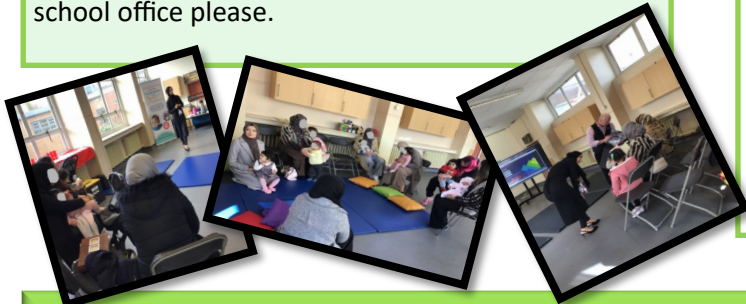
