All items of our uniform can be bought in local shops or supermarkets with the exception of sweatshirts and cardigans with our school logo. School specific sweatshirts and cardigans can be purchased from the Mansuri store at the Yew Tree or via the Mansuri website www.mansuri.co.uk. Book bags and P.E. bags with the school logo can also be purchased from Mansuri. It is parental choice to purchase items with the school logo on. It is not required by the school; we ask parents to maintain the school's colours.

We do not expect parents to be spending a lot of money on uniform. Plain jumpers and cardigans in bottle green can be bought from many supermarkets / clothes shops. From our research, we can see that they can be bought from:

Second-hand items

The school receives and welcomes donations of school uniform items no longer needed. If you would like to enquire about purchasing second hand uniform items, please contact the school directly.

We hold regular swap shops, where parents can pick up unclaimed uniform items from lost property. Swap shop dates will be advertised on the school newsletter.

Uniform for boys;

White polo shirt / bottle green sweatshirt / grey or black trousers / flat, black shoes.

Uniform for girls;

Flat, black shoes or boots / grey or black socks, grey or black tights or grey or black leggings / white polo shirt / bottle green cardigan or sweatshirt / grey or black skirt, grey or black pinafore or grey or black trousers

Or

Black, green or white headscarf or hijab / bottle green cardigan or sweatshirt.

Summer uniform for girls (optional);

Green gingham summer dress / white socks, white tights or white leggings

Summer uniform for boys (optional);

White polo shirt / grey or black trouser shorts / flat, black shoes.



PE uniform for all children (Reception to Year 6);

White t-shirt (<u>not</u> the polo shirt worn daily), black shorts or jogging bottoms / black sweatshirt / black pumps or plain black trainers.

PE kits are to be kept in school every day in a clearly labelled bag.

Things to remember:

- No drop or hooped earrings or bangles are to be worn in school. Pupils may wear small stud earrings. Sikh children may wear their Kara but it must be covered with an elastic bandage or sweat band for P.E.
- No jewellery, other than that stated above, is allowed in school
- Hairbands, bows and clips must be white, green, grey or black no decorative hair accessories
- Any other decisions are based on health and safety grounds
- Please label all items of clothing, including coats, with the child's name
