Children will investigate different methods of communication and evaluate which methods of internet communication to use for particular purposes. They will also learn how to code.

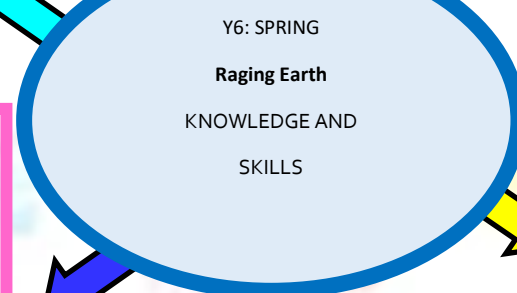
English WRITING

Children will:

- Identify the audience for and purpose of writing
- Focus: Writing to Discuss, Persuade, and Inform.
- Key Learning: Cohesion, varied sentence structures, effective use of punctuation (bullets, dashes, hyphens).
- Discuss: Explore debate topics, write about personal issues, and evaluate effective arguments.
- Persuade: Write formal letters to celebrities, using persuasive devices and formal tone.
- Inform: Create WWII-inspired recounts or diaries, focusing on first-person narrative and precise vocabulary.

Spelling & Handwriting: Statutory word lists, prefixes, and practising fluency.

- Consider tense
- Use varied sentences
- Use colon to introduce a list
- Punctuate accurately



PSHE: Belonging to a community/ Money and work

Children will learn:

- About the benefits of a diverse community
- About stereotypes and how they can negatively influence behaviours and attitudes towards others
- About prejudice and how to recognise behaviours/actions which discriminate against others

Children will learn:

MFL- French

PE: Dance/ Cricket

PE Dance Unit

Children will:

- Work collaboratively to perform a dance routine that includes lifts and jumps
- Compose a dance in unison
- Link street dance actions in group sequence

PE Cricket Unit

Children will:

- Successfully throw and catch when under pressure
- Learn how to bowl correctly, replication a bowling technique
- Understand how to grip a cricket bat and take a good batting position
- Outwit opponents in a game

SCIENCE: Heart and Lungs

Children will:

- Describe the functions of blood
- Be able to explain the functions of blood vessels
- Explain the functions of the heart
- Describe the structure of the circulatory system
- Understand how the lungs work
- Describe the changes that take place in pulse rate and breathing rate before, during and after exercise
- Describe the ways in which nutrients and water are transported within animals, including humans
- Recognise the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the way bodies function.

GEOGRAPHY:

Children will:

- Understand how earthquakes occur and the effects of them
- Understand the role of tectonic plates in causing natural disasters.
- Understand the impact of natural disasters.
- Compare and evaluate the measures the UK takes to protect against natural disasters
