Here are our latest entry routes:

- **Professional Policing Degree (PPD)** this route is specifically for graduates of the PPD and are now applying for roles in their chosen force.





- Officer training including degree apprenticeship (PCDA) a policing degree apprenticeship, studying and training for three years.
- **Graduate entry route (DHEP)** for graduates, training alongside studying for a graduate diploma, taking two years.
- Graduate entry route with detective training (DC DHEP) for graduates, training as a detective, studying for a graduate diploma, taking two years.
