Dear Parents/Carers

Re: Change to the Academy Day

I am writing to inform you of important changes to the academy day, starting in September 2023.

As you may be aware, from September 2023 the Government have stated that there is an expectation that all schools should offer a minimum school week of not less than 32.5 hours per week. The current school week at Hollingworth consists of 30 hours 25 minutes for Key Stage 3 pupils, and 30 hours 50 minutes for Key Stage 4 pupils.

To accommodate the additional hours, we have been looking at several proposals and, after consideration, we have now decided on the following, which will take effect from September 2023:

There are no changes to the start of the school day.

Monday to Friday – school will start at 8.40am, as normal, for all pupils.

There will be a slightly later finishing time. School will finish at 3.10pm, as opposed to 2.50pm. Monday to Friday – school will finish at 3.10pm, for all pupils.

We appreciate that this may have an impact on families but hope you will be supportive of the change.
