**WORKPLACE EXPERIENCE:** Offer students a tour of your premises, speed networking with key staff, and a hands-on task for valuable industry insights.



**GROUP MENTORING:** Spend an hour on a Tuesday mentoring small groups of students to boost their aspirations and engagement.
