The following are not permitted:

- False eyelashes
- False nails
- False tan
- Unnatural hair colouring
- Excessive make up (for Year 10 and 11 pupils, make up is not permitted for Years 7, 8 and 9 pupils)
- Facial piercings
- Jewellery*
- Socks worn over tights – pupils should wear **either** plain black socks **or** plain black tights – **not both**.

*Wristwatches may be worn and one pair of small, plain stud earrings, no more than 5mm in diameter.

Any pupils consistently in breach of our uniform policy may receive sanctions such as internal exclusion. If this is not corrected in a timely manner, further sanctions may come into effect.
