Finally, we will be focusing on Christmas and why we celebrate this holiday.	<b><u>The World!</u></b>  In this topic we will be exploring the world around us! We will start by looking where we have travelled on our holidays and then looking closely at the seven continents. We will look at the weather, food, animals and festivals that different countries have.	<b><u>Out of this World!</u></b>  In this topic we will be exploring outer space! We will look at the planet Earth, the moon, Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune and try to find out if aliens really exist! We will also look at the famous astronaut Neil Armstrong.	<b><u>Under the Sea!</u></b>  In this topic we will be exploring under the sea and learning about our oceans.
