Dear Parents, Relatives and Carers,

Firstly, I would like to begin by commending Year 11 on their excellent behaviour and effort so far during the exam period. Many staff have spoken to me about the exceptional attitude and resilience of the pupils and this is reinforcing what I am seeing on a daily basis.

Secondly, I just wanted to reiterate and provide further information on the plans for after half term:

- Pupils will finish for half term at **1pm on Friday 24th May.** This is an early finish. A bus will be provided.
- Over the half term break, there are a number of revision sessions taking place, including maths, English and history. A full timetable will be provided for students via announcements on Class Charts. There is no transport provided so pupils will be required to make their own way to and from school.
- After the half term break, starting on **Monday 3rd June**, pupils will only be required to attend school for exams and specific revision sessions.
- This will mean there are days that pupils are not required to attend school.
- On days when a pupil has a morning exam, they need to arrive in school by 8:45am.
- If a pupil has a morning revision session, they need to arrive in school by 8:45am.
- On days when a pupil has an afternoon exam, they need to arrive in school by 11am.
 Pupils will always have a revision session before an afternoon exam. Please be aware that there is no bus running to bring students in at this time.
- A timetable of all exams and revision sessions will be provided.
- When a pupil does not have an exam or a revision session, they are not required to attend school and can revise at home. However, if a pupil wishes to attend, there will be supervised study rooms provided.
- External exams conclude at different points for pupils.
- Pupils are required to remain in full school uniform for the entirety of this period. Any poor behaviour or failure to meet the school's standards of uniform or behaviour may result in them missing out on the Leaver's Day Celebration and/or Prom.

Finally, for those pupils who are eligible, you are now able to pay for Prom on Scopay.

Once again, myself and all the staff would like to wish our pupils the very best of luck in their remaining exams and future endeavours.
