Dear Parent/Guardian

As part of the Geography GCSE course we have arranged a fieldwork visit to Liverpool Docks, Baltic Triangle, and city centre on <u>Tuesday 11th or Thursday 13th February 2025</u> for Year 11 Geography students. We will be leaving school at <u>9am</u> and will return by <u>3pm.</u> The class teacher will tell pupils which day they are attending.

The purpose of the fieldwork is for pupils to investigate regeneration in Liverpool and the subsequent impacts of this redevelopment of the city in preparation for their final GCSE exam. During the day, students will be carrying out four different fieldwork techniques to support them in completing their paper 3 exam. Therefore, this is a compulsory field visit, as it is a requirement to fulfil the course.

On the day students are to wear their own clothes but sensible warm clothing is required as most of the primary data will be collected outside. Flat shoes or trainers for easy walking are essential. For the day students will need a pen, pencil, and a camera or camera phone would also be useful. Students may either bring a packed lunch or money to buy lunch in Liverpool One.

Students are to attend registration to be marked present in school and then meet at <u>8:50am</u> at the front reception. The bus will return for 2:55pm.

There is a cost for transport for this field visit and to cover small group fieldwork technique sessions. We please ask for a contribution of £7 to help school cover the cost of transport as pupils need to go to several locations. Please pay using Scopay, this will also provide consent for your child to attend.

If your child receives free school meals the field visit is covered by government funds as the trip is compulsory to complete the course. The canteen will also provide a packed lunch if required.
