Dear Parent

Year 9 Options Information Evening, Thursday 20th March 2025 @ 6.00 p.m. (School Hall)

This is the term that your child will make their Key Stage 4 option choices. On Thursday 20th March at 6.00 p.m. in the School Hall, we are hosting an 'Options Information Evening' about the processes and timeline for choosing their options. All parents are welcome to attend. If you are unable to attend we will make the presentation and options booklet available to you on the school's website.

We recognise that making decisions about what subjects to study in Year 10 and thinking about future career choices may seem daunting. What is most important is that all students select subjects that best suit their needs and aspirations. With this in mind there are a number of events taking place this term to help support you and your child in making these decisions:

The key dates are as follows:

Year 9 Options Evening -Thursday 20th March. Start time - 6.00 p.m.

This will be an opportunity for parents to hear about the options process and to explain the pathways students can follow, along with guidance on how to choose. This will be held in the school hall.

Monday 24th March – Friday 28th March

Assemblies are being held to inform our children of the options available and the process/timeline. In these assemblies all subjects will talk about their subject content in Years 10 & 11, and how they are examined.

Thursday 27thth March, Year 9 Parent's Evening on the School Cloud

This is an opportunity to discuss your child's progress with their subject teachers and for them to answer any questions you may have about options.

Friday 4th April

Deadline for options to be submitted online.

Additional Support

Options booklet – a booklet will be available for students and parents which provides information about the subjects they can study and the options process. This will also be made available via our website.

Student Interviews - Student interviews will take place this term, giving students the opportunity to discuss the most appropriate pathway and subjects for them. Parents can also request a meeting with staff if they would like more support during the process.

Options and Pathways

All our students study the following:

- English Language and English Literature (2 GCSEs)
- Mathematics (1 GCSE)
- Combined Science (2 GCSEs)
- RE (1 GCSE)
- Core PE (not examined)
- Personal Development (not examined)
- 3 option subjects

They then have to choose a 'pathway'.

Ebacc Pathway

You may be aware that there is a national expectation that a certain percentage of students should follow an Ebacc pathway. To achieve the Ebacc, students must to take a Humanity subject (Geography or History) <u>and</u> a Modern Foreign Language (French or Spanish). Some children may be encouraged to consider an Ebacc pathway.
