Places are available on a first come first served basis. Places need to be confirmed by the 14th October with a £200 deposit. Payable in cash to Becky Bell or on SCOPAY. Reply slips must be returned to Becky Bell when booking.

Day 1 (Mon 14th Jul) - Flight to Barcelona

Arrive at school at 7.00am for a coach pick up to Manchester Airport. Arrive at Manchester Airport 10:40 Ryanair flight from Manchester Airport to Barcelona 14:05 Arrive to Barcelona and collect bags. Students are allowed a 10kg case and a carry on bag. Collect your 4 day (96hr) HOLA travel cards from kiosks in the airport and make your own way to accommodation on public transport Arrive at accommodation to drop off bags In the afternoon, group to explore Plaza Catalunya and La Rambla Evening meal at local restaurant

Day 2 (Tue 15th Jul) - Sagrada Familia & Park Guell

Breakfast in accommodation Day to be spent exploring Barcelona on foot or using your HOLA cards In the morning enjoy a guided visit to the Sagrada Familia (included) Time to buy lunch (at own expense) In the afternoon to enjoy a guided visit to Park Guell (included) If time allows, perhaps explore the Gothic Quarter Evening meal at local restaurant

Day 3 (Wed 16th Jul) - Camp Nou, Poble Espanyol & Montjuic

Breakfast in accommodation Day to be spent exploring Barcelona on foot or using your HOLA cards In the morning group to enjoy a visit to the Camp Nou Immersive Experience (included) Time to buy lunch (at own expense) In the afternoon enjoy a self-guided visit to Poble Espanyol (included) Followed by a return trip on the Montjuic cable car (included) to enjoy the views of the city Evening meal at local restaurant

Day 4 (Thu 17th Jul) - Picasso & return to the UK

Breakfast in accommodation Check out of accommodation & store luggage (subject to availability) Day to be spent exploring Barcelona on foot or using your HOLA cards In the morning group to visit the Picasso Museum (included) Time to buy lunch (at own expense) Free time in the afternoon for last minute sightseeing and souvenir shopping Return to the accommodation to collect luggage Make your own way to airport using your HOLA cards Check in for flight 20:50 Ryanair flight departs Barcelona Airport 22:25 Flight arrives at Manchester Airport a coach will be there to pick students and staff up and return to school.
