Dear Students and Parents/Guardians

Re: Arrangements for GCSE Results Day – Thursday 20th August 2026

As we approach the end of the academic year, I would like to inform you of the arrangements for GCSE Results Day, which will take place on Thursday 20th August 2026.

We would also like to offer a new service using the department for Education app called 'Education Record England'. Please ensure you have completed steps 1 and 2 before arriving on results day.

1. Install the official "Education Record England" app from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store.
2. **Log In:** Open the app and log in using your standard UK gov.uk One Login details (or create a new account if you do not have one yet).
3. Sit with a member of staff on results day who will generate a unique QR code for you to scan onto your phone. This securely links your DfE-issued data to the app. Your GCSE and other official qualification results will automatically load directly into your app.
4. The app's built-in share feature will allow you to instantly send your verified results and information to sixth-form colleges, training providers, or future employers.

To allow time to activate the new app, and to minimise congestion, we have arranged staggered collection times indicated below. It is really important to have the app pre-installed and logged in before arrival.

After collecting their results, students will have the opportunity to speak with staff from Holy Family Sixth Form College for course enrolment. For students intending to continue their studies elsewhere, many local colleges provide application forms on their websites, and we encourage early applications. Members of the Senior Leadership Team and Careers staff will also be available on the day to provide advice and guidance.
