## Dear Parent/Guardian

As part of the Geography GCSE course, we have arranged a fieldwork visit to Stanley Docks, Albert Docks, Baltic Triangle, and Liverpool One on **Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> November 2025** for Year 11 Geography students. We will be leaving school at **9am** and will return for **4pm**. The late bus will be available to take students home.

The purpose of the fieldwork is for pupils to investigate regeneration in Liverpool and the subsequent impacts of this redevelopment of the city in preparation for their final GCSE exam. During the day, students will be carrying out four different fieldwork techniques to support them in completing their paper 3 exam. Therefore, this is a compulsory field visit, as it is a requirement to fulfil the course.

This fieldwork will also be tested in their December mocks.

On the day students are to wear their **own clothes**, sensible warm clothing as the primary data will be collected outside. Flat shoes or trainers are essential. For the day students will need a pen and pencil. If available a mobile phone to take pictures of each location would be useful. Students may either bring a packed lunch or money to buy lunch in Liverpool One.

Any pupil who receives free school meals will be given a packed lunch plus drink if requested through their class teacher.

There is a cost for transport for this field visit and to cover small group fieldwork technique sessions. We please ask for a contribution of £8.50 to help school cover the cost of transport as pupils need to go to several locations to complete their data collection. Please pay using <a href="ScoPay">ScoPay</a>, this will also provide consent for your child to attend.

Students are to attend registration to be marked as present and then meet at **8:55 am** outside the TECH BLOCK. The bus will return for **4pm**.
