## Passport to Prom

Congratulations to all students who fully engaged in their learning last term and achieved the **Passport to Prom** target of **200 merits by Christmas**—some students even reached close to 400 merits!

Students are now challenged to gain an additional **200 merits by Easter** (400 in total). Merits are awarded weekly for:

- Zero demerits (2 merits)
- 100% attendance (2 merits)
- Tassomai (up to 5 merits per week)
- After-school intervention sessions (5 merits per session)
- Sparx (2 merits per week)

Additional merits can be earned through contributions to school life and active participation in lessons. Students will also receive **10 merits for every target grade achieved in the March mocks**.

Please note: Any demerits for incomplete homework, poor punctuality, or inappropriate behaviour will affect the overall merit total. You can monitor your child's behaviour record via **Class Charts**. Contact me if you require login details.

## Prom Requirements

In addition to meeting the merit goal, students must:

- Maintain an excellent behaviour record
- Meet all coursework deadlines
- Have no more than **2 Progress Leader detentions** and **no Headteacher detentions**
- No exclusions
- Maintain excellent attendance and punctuality
- Follow the school uniform policy

Students who repeatedly fail to comply with uniform expectations risk not being allowed to attend the Prom.

If a student is at risk of not meeting the requirements, there will be opportunities for “**Payback to Prom**”, which will be explained to them if appropriate.
