Dear Parents/Guardians and Year 13 Students,

As we approach the conclusion of the academic year, I am writing to provide you with important information regarding the arrangements for Year 13 students during the examination period and the final weeks of Sixth Form.

Timetables for the individual students will be available in an assembly on Friday 17th April, students must attend this to get their exam timetables. Students are expected to be in school when they do not have examinations, as there is no study leave in place. We strongly encourage students to make effective use of their free periods for revision, whether in school or at home, and we greatly appreciate the continued support of parents and guardians in helping to maintain good study routines. Students studying BTEC courses will continue to attend as required in order to complete and sign off their qualifications.

We are looking forward to marking the end of students' time in Sixth Form with our Leavers' Event, which will take place on Friday 5th June. On this day, food will be available from 11:00am, followed by speeches and the leavers' video at 12:00pm. Students are reminded that they are still expected to attend any scheduled revision sessions or lessons up until the completion of their final examinations. Members of the Sixth Form team will be available from 8:30am to provide guidance and support, including assistance with university applications and the clearing process where necessary. Staff will remain available throughout the day, and on the following day, to ensure that all students are supported in securing appropriate next steps.
