REWARD TRIP TO ALTON TOWERS

We will be rewarding a number of our students for their outstanding achievements this year, by inviting them to take part in a trip to **Alton Towers**. To be able to attend this trip, we expect students to achieve a **minimum net balance of 100 Class Charts behaviour points this term**. We will take this figure, as it stands, at **15:00** on the **13th June 2025**. Progress Leaders and SLT also reserve the right to make any final decision on any student's eligibility for the trip. Pupils will also not be eligible for the trip if they have received two Progress Leader's detention, one Headteacher's detention or served either an internal or external suspension, during this term.

The contribution cost of the trip is approximately **£50.00** which covers the cost of the coach and entry to the venue. **The deadline for payment will be the 20th June at 3pm. Late payments cannot be accepted.** You will be asked to please pay via '[Scopay](#)'. The trip will be taking place on Tuesday 15th July.

If your child is eligible to attend, they will receive an invitation, so **you need not take action now**, other than encourage your child to reach the required merits by being the best that they can be. Pupils will begin to receive invitations when they become eligible from the 2nd June onwards.

Please note carefully: The Ride Access Pass is a system Alton Towers have in place to help guests who require extra assistance or are unable to queue due to a condition or disability.
