Dear Parents, Relatives and Carers,

REWARD TRIP TO ALTON TOWERS

We will be rewarding a number of our students for their outstanding achievements, by inviting them to take part in a trip to **Alton Towers**. To be able to attend this trip, we expect students to achieve a **minimum net balance of 130 Class Charts behaviour points this term, starting on Monday 13th April. We will take this figure, as it stands, at 15:30 on the 25th June 2026.** Progress Leaders and SLT also reserve the right to make any final decision on any student's eligibility for the trip.

Pupils will also not be eligible for the trip if they have received any of the following this term:

- two Progress Leader's detention
- one Headteacher's detention
- an internal or external suspension

The contribution cost of the trip is approximately **£50.00 which** covers the cost of the coach and entry to the venue. **The deadline for payment will be the 2nd July at 3pm. Late payments cannot be accepted.** You will be asked to please pay via 'Scopay'.

The trip will be taking place on Wednesday 15th July.

If your child is eligible to attend, they will receive an invitation, so **you need not take action now**, other than encourage your child to reach the required merits by being the best that they can be.

Please note carefully: The Ride Access Pass is a system Alton Towers have in place to help guests who require extra assistance or are unable to queue due to a condition or disability.
