Dear Parent, Relative or Carer,

Rewards Trip to Alton Towers – Wednesday 15th July 2026

Your child is invited to take part in the rewards trip to Alton Towers.

Arrangements

The trip will take place on Wednesday 15th July 2025. **Students are required to be at school for 7.10am to depart for Alton Towers via coach.** Please ensure your child arrives promptly. We will depart Alton Towers at 6:30pm and return to school at approximately 8.30pm. Please be aware that there are no school buses running at these times and pupils will need to make their own arrangements for getting to and from school. Students are not required to wear school uniform but please ensure sensible clothes are worn to suit the weather conditions as they will spend most of the day outside. Students will need to bring their own lunch. There are facilities to purchase food on site; however, at peak times they can be very busy and are expensive.

The contribution cost of the trip is **£50.00** which covers the cost of the coach and entry into Alton Towers.

If you would like your child to attend the trip please pay **£50.00** via SCOPAY. The final deadline for payment is **Friday 3rd July**. Pupils will not be able to attend the trip without parental consent, which can be given on Scopay, when making payment.

Any student eligible for Pupil Premium will have a packed lunch provided. If there are any other queries, please do not hesitate to contact us at school.

The Ride Access Pass

Some pupils may be eligible for a "Ride Access Pass". The Ride Access Pass is a system Alton Towers have in place to help guests who require extra assistance or are unable to queue due to a condition or disability.
