Dear Parent or Carer

Your child is invited to take part in a trip to the Plaza Cinema in Waterloo to view the film "*The Island* on *Bird Street*" on **Thursday 25th January 2024**. This is in observation of *Holocaust Memorial Day* as the film is about a Jewish teenage boy who tries to survive in a Polish Ghetto during the events of the Holocaust. The film is suitable for Years5/6 and above and it does not show any upsetting images associated with the Holocaust or genocide (The film itself is rated PG-13).

We intend to leave Holy Family High School at 9:00am so your child should arrive to school at normal time (for 8:45am where they will be registered as usual). They will be required to be in **full uniform** as there will be other schools at the cinema at the same time. We intend to return to school for roughly 1pm so they should be able to access (most if not all) of periods 4 & 5 so please ensure they have equipment packed for these lessons.

I recommend your children packing a packed-lunch, if your child is in receipt of free school meals please tick the box below on the consent slip and the school canteen will provide one for your child. This trip will be entirely **free of charge** and will only require consent. The trip will unfortunately be on a first come, first serve basis as a result of the limited number of seats on the mini-bus.


