Key Stage 2 Teacher (Teacher Main Pay Scale) (one-year contract initially)

Thank you for your interest in this post at Holy Family Catholic High School. Holy Family is a friendly, successful and heavily over-subscribed school with a vacancy for an enthusiastic primary teacher to join our talented staff. This is an exciting opportunity for a highly committed teacher with a real passion for improving pupil's life chances. We want you to inspire our pupils and give them the necessary skills to be able to access their KS3 curriculum. You will also have the opportunity to work with a caring and committed team of teachers and you will be supported by an excellent CPD programme.

This post is a first for us. We have reviewed all of our support and intervention programmes and we feel we need to appoint a qualified primary teacher to complement the skills we have in school. The person will be working closely with our Intervention Lead in making sure that we identify and support our pupils most in need. This will initially be offered as a one-year contract with the expectation that it will become a permanent post in school.

The post will be approximately:

- 25% timetabled maths teaching this will be to a class in Year 7 and a class in Year 8 who are working below their age related expectations (ARE). The pupils need to consolidate and build on their skills developed during KS2 to help them access the KS3 curriculum.
- 25% timetabled booster lessons this will be to classes in Year's 7 & 8 who need additional support to develop their core literacy skills to help them access their KS3 curriculum.
- 50% intervention lessons this will be working with our Intervention Lead to identify and support groups of Year 7 & 8 pupils who are working below their ARE. These sessions/lessons will require a flexible approach depending on the needs of the pupils. The main aim will be to develop their reading skills.

Holy Family is an ambitious, high achieving, 11-18 mixed Voluntary Aided School, where young people feel safe and happy. We aim to create a supportive, caring but challenging environment for our young people, giving them the self-confidence and belief to realise their ambitions. We are aspirational for them all and strive to meet the needs of every child, irrespective of ability, to ensure they maximise their potential both in and out of the classroom.
