New Year 7 Intake 2024

Student Admission & Consent Form

The information you provide us with is essential in ensuring accurate records in many important areas. Please can you indicate on this form who the student lives with, who has parental responsibility and the order in which these people should be contacted in an emergency. In the interests of safety, it is important that we have at least two (ideally three) emergency contacts for your child.

Free School Meals

School Meals

A sample menu is included in the Information Booklet. The price of a set meal deal is currently £2.85, but this may increase from September. We use cashless dining facilities in school. All pupils will be provided with an individual card onto which money can be paid using the machines located in the canteens or, ideally, via our online school payment system (Scopay – A link code to set up this account will be sent out shortly). Those on Free School Meals will have the credit applied automatically to these cards.

School Uniform

During the New Intake Information Evening we will discuss our school uniform requirements. I am conscious, however, that some parents may wish to start purchasing items of uniform prior to this date.
