This week, I would like to introduce you to an exciting project that I would like as many as possible to get involved in between now and September. '**Be Awesome, Go Big**' is an interactive package to help Year 6 students' transition into secondary school. It can be used by students and parents at home and is designed to be motivational, helpful and reassuring and to help young people feel valued, loved, encouraged and equipped for the journey ahead. There are nine tasks and students should work through the resources at their own pace. Having used this with my own child, I think it is a great activity in preparation for moving to 'big' school.
