Dear Parents,

On Thursday 12th December, we will be holding our annual Year 7 sleepover. The aim of the sleepover is to raise money for the Indian Hope Orphan Project.

Several years ago, we decided to adopt a charity where the money raised on the night is sent. This charity is an orphanage school in India. Last year we raised £2200 and helped buy every child a brand new uniform.

I understand that this time of year can prove expensive, but your support is always greatly appreciated. Should you decide to allow your child to take part in the sleepover, they should return the reply slip below to their Form Tutor.

On Thursday 12th December, your child should attend school in full uniform with their books and equipment. They will leave school at 3.10pm as normal and return to school, ready for the sleepover at 9.00pm. I would advise that they have their tea before coming back to school as the aim of the evening is to be 'homeless' for the night and soup will be served from the school dining room.

It is important that your child returns to school in comfortable clothes that they can sleep in as well as wear for school the next day, e.g. a tracksuit of jogging pants and a t-shirt. They should also bring with them; a sleeping bag and pillow (in a named bin bag), as they will be sleeping on the floor in the school hall. They do not need to bring their school books for Friday's lessons with them. Your child doesn't need to bring their phone, iPad or tablet etc. as they can be lost or damaged.

If your child is on any form of medication that requires doses being administered during the course of the sleepover and Friday in school, please make sure this information is completed on the slip below.

As we are raising money your child will be issued with a sponsorship card. The person that raises the highest single total and brings it with them to the sleepover will receive a prize. In recent years, parents have taken sponsorship cards into work and around family members. The highest single amount by an individual currently stands at £500. I know that this year's Year 7 can beat that total.
