
What information is in my report?

Understanding Reports in Pupil Progress





Make sure your parent has the App too!

They do two things:
1. Download the App on their phone.
2. Use the link in the <u>invitation email</u> to open and activate the App.

Activating your App – pupils.

- Open the email invitation and click on the link. This link activates your account.
- You use your <u>school email</u> address and <u>password</u> to access Pupil Progress App.




