You will gain an insight into the create IT and Media sector as you investigate the pace of technological change, IT infrastructure, the flow of information on a global scale, and the importance of legal and security considerations. The Level 3 Cambridge Technicals will focus on the requirements that today's universities and employers demand.

By studying The Level 3 Cambridge Technicals in Creative IT and Media, learners develop knowledge, understanding and skills required by the sector, including essential employability skills, and apply them in real work contexts.

When it comes to progression or employment, you will learn about the variety of opportunities available to you, and the roles and responsibilities of IT and Media businesses and organisations within the sector. This will make sure you develop clear ideas about where you might like to take your career and what progression routes you'd like to follow.

The qualification also provides a well-established route into a variety of specialist Higher Education (HE) courses in this sector, when taken alongside other qualifications appropriate for the desired course of study. UCAS has reviewed the qualification to assess its value for access to higher education, and has allocated UCAS points.

The course consists of five units of work that will be completed over two years. Two of these units will be external examinations with the remaining three being coursework

Entry Requirements:

At least 5 GCSEs at grades 4 or above including GCSE Maths and English.
