Please note that EYFS, KS1 (infant) children will only be released to an adult at home time. No infant children will be released to walk home by themselves. Parents must inform the school office or class teacher if another person is collecting their child. If this person is not known to school, a password may be given to be checked by the class teacher on collection of the child.

KS2 children may be released to a sibling of secondary school age if needed, but for safeguarding and safety reasons, being released to an adult is preferred. If a parent wishes for their KS2 child to walk home, they must consent to this via the MCAS app. Also please note that if your child is coming to school on a bike or scooter, wearing a helmet is a safer option.
