Admissions and Open evening

If you have a child born between **1st September 2020** and **31st August 2021**, you must apply for a primary school Reception (EYFS) place for September 2024. (Applications are required for all children with a 4th birthday between 1st September 2024 and 31st August 2025.)

Secondary School applications

If you have a child born between 1 September 2013 - 31 Aug 2014, you must apply for a secondary school (Year 7) place for September 2024

If you live in Blackpool (pay council tax to Blackpool) apply online: <u>www.blackpool.gov.uk/schooladmissions</u>

The closing date for secondary applications is the **31 October 2024**

It is important that all parents make their choice online by the deadline and that two choices are made, otherwise your child will be allocated a school with free spaces (which is often miles away!).
