Please send your child in warm coats and label any hats/gloves/scarves as these are easily lost. Please consider tights for girls in skirts as it is bitterly cold on our playground!

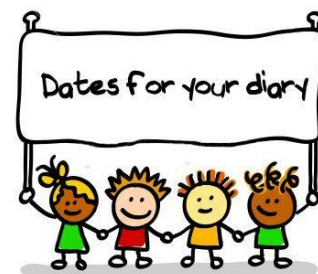
