Dear parents and carers,

We are fast approaching your child's final day of primary school! This half term is extremely busy with events such as Youth Games week, play rehearsals and transition days. Here are some key dates for your diaries. Further information regarding Leavers events will be sent out separately.

Despite being so busy, there will still be plenty of learning taking place. Most of our class work will support the transition to High School as we ensure pupils are 'Ready to Learn' in Year 7. In maths, we will start learning about algebra. Pupils will learn to use simple formulae, describe number sequences using letters as symbols and find unknowns in an equation. In English, we will study classic poetry, in particular Marriott Edgar's 'The Lion and Albert'. This will also link to our work on reading fluency.

RE this half term will see pupils learning about other world faiths, beginning with a trip to the Manjushri Kadampa Meditation Centre. In PE lessons, Mrs Salt and Mrs Kelsh-Ridge will be focusing on football and orienteering. In the wider curriculum, we will be taking part in a whole school Safety Week with our focus being on financial safety.

Our Mass this half term is Leavers' Mass on Thursday 16th July. This is a wonderful celebration of your child's time at Holy Family and is also when the End of Year Awards presentation takes place. Parents/carers will be notified in advance if their child is receiving an award.

Please continue to support your child with learning their lines for the play, ensuring they add expression and actions where appropriate. This will replace homework for this half term so please do encourage your child to dedicate time to it. Rehearsals without the use of a script will start to take place the week beginning 22nd June. A letter regarding times and arrangements for the night of the play will be sent out shortly.
