Understand:

UI.1.1	Retell the story of Creation in Genesis 1:1-4, 24-26.	
UI.1.2	Know that all that is comes from God, our Father, who made heaven and Earth.	
UI.1.3	Recognise that though people cannot see God, they can see Him through the wonder of Creation.	
UI.1.4	God gave us the responsibility to take care of the world and its people and in doing this, we show love for God and each other.	
UI.1.5	Know that Pope Francis wrote a letter, called Laudato Si', about the gift of Creation and the importance of taking care of the world as it is everyone's home.	
UI.1.6	Recognise that prayer is a way of drawing closer to God.
