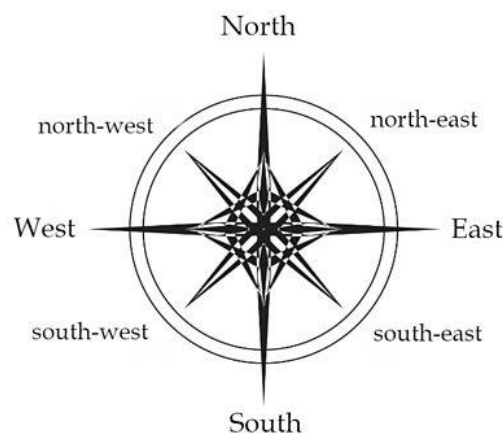

Understand:

1	Children to recognise the 8 key compass points and what these are abbreviated to ?

4	Name and locate counties and cities of the United Kingdom, geographical regions and their identifying human and physical characteristics
5	To label key topographical features (including hills, mountains, coasts and rivers), and land-use patterns
