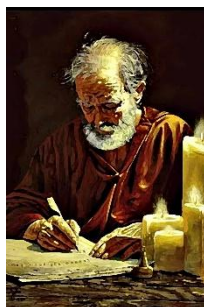

Understand

U3.5.1.	Link the Scripture (Lk 24:13-35 and Matt 28:16-20) and what happens at Mass.	
U3.5.2.	Know about God as Trinity and describe some signs and symbols of the Holy Trinity. Christians make the sign of the cross as a prayerful reminder of their baptism through the Holy Spirit.	
U3.5.3.	Know the prayers - Glory Be and Come Holy Spirit.	
U3.5.4.	Know that Mary joins the disciples in prayer and that we ask for Mary's prayers.	
U3.5.5.	Think about the life of the early Church and how we gather for Mass today.	
U3.5.6.	We learn about the life of Jesus in the gospels, the work of the disciples in the Acts and learn that Paul wrote letters to the early Christian communities.
