- Large scale – large amount of detail; can only show small area
- Small scale – small amount of detail; can show a large area

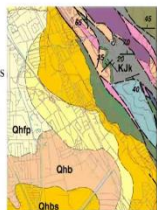
Large Scale

1:16,000
