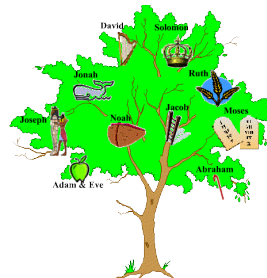
Prophecy and Promise
