School Admission - Notes for Guidance

All applicants for in year admissions to Blackpool schools have the right to express up to three school preferences. These will be considered equally by the Local Authority (LA) in liaison, where necessary, with Lancashire County Council. A single offer of a school place will be made to each applicant.

Applications for Blackpool Schools are only valid if they are made on Blackpool's in year application form IAP 112018. If you live in Lancashire you must contact School Access on 01524 581148, even if you wish to apply for a Blackpool School.

OFFERS FOR SCHOOL PLACES

Blackpool Council co-ordinates all in year school admissions i.e. new to area and school transfers between Blackpool Schools. The Local Authority responsible for admission to all community and voluntary controlled schools. The Governing **Bodies** voluntary aided (faith), Academies and Schools are responsible admissions to their schools.

Blackpool Council will liaise with Lancashire County Council (LCC) as necessary in relation to each application.

Only offers from the Admissions Authority are valid. Verbal offers made by individual school staff have no legal status. A school place can only be accessed after written confirmation of an offer by the Local Authority.

The Local Authority will endeavour to issue offers within 10 school days of receipt of an in year application form (subject in some cases to accuracy checks and the availability of relevant background information).

If a school place is offered and this is then found to have been based upon inaccurate or misleading information then it may be withdrawn. This can apply even where a child has started at the school.

If offers for more than one of your preferred schools are possible then the single offer will be for the one which you prioritised highest on your application.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION FORMS (SIFs)

Voluntary aided schools may have a Supplementary Information Form (SIF) which allows the school's Governing Body to assess applications against certain criteria within their admission arrangements. It is not always necessary for parents to complete a SIF.

CHILDREN IN PUBLIC CARE (LOOKED AFTER CHILDREN - LAC)

Children who are in public care have top priority for admission to Blackpool schools. In some cases the preferred school (s) may already be full and places cannot normally be offered. The Local Authority will, however, look at each LAC application and determine if discretion is possible (in liaison with other admission authorities where necessary).

EDUCATION, HEALTH AND CARE PLANS previously known as Statements of Special Educational Needs (SEN)

In year applications for children with Education, health and care plans (full statements for SEN) are dealt with separately. Contact your current named SEN Officer and inform them that you are moving. The Blackpool Statutory Assessment Team can be contacted on 01253 476553 if you have any questions. Applications will be referred to the Statutory Assessment Team who will liaise with the family and other professionals involved about a school place for your child.

APPEALS FOR SCHOOL PLACES

If none of your preferred schools can be offered an alternative offer will always be made (unless the child already has a place at a Blackpool school). The LA will also issue appeal information and an appeal form.

If you are unhappy with any school offer you can appeal for any other school (s) which at that time have no available places. Information and advice is available from The School Admissions Team. Parents are advised to visit an offered school prior to going to appeal.
