Bookings for breakfast club should be made 24 hours in advance.

Bookings for after school club can be made up to 12.30 pm on the day of the club. We can sometimes accommodate on the day bookings, but this should not be on a regular basis as places can't be guaranteed.

Please make sure that regular payments are made to your child's accounts for sessions taken.
