Gummies Information Reminder

The Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency (MHRA) recently issued a press release to advise parents and caregivers to stop all use of a specific brand of kids' magnesium gummies, due to the presence of an undeclared prescription-only medicine. Parents and caregivers who have purchased 'Nutrition Ignition Kids Magnesium Glycinate Gummies' should stop giving them to children and safely dispose of any remaining product.
