As you may be aware by recent news coverage, from August 2024, the Government have introduced new stricter guidance for schools and local authorities to follow, with more fines and sanctions imposed for unauthorised and unexplained absences.

We would like to highlight the impact that absence during term time can have on a child's learning. Under the guidance, absences for holidays and events during term time will not be authorised and we would really like to discourage children missing school for such occasions.
