Important Notice About School Uniform

We are always proud of how smart our children look in their school uniform. However, we would like to remind parents/carers about the requirements for hair, jewellery, nail varnish and accessories.

- Jewellery Only one pair of stud earrings, no other piercings are permitted. A sensible wrist watch. No other items of jewellery should be worn. All items must be removed during practical lessons, such as PE and sporting activities.
 Make Up The wearing of makeup is not permitted. Ealer pails and mail extensions are not normitted.
- False nails and mail extensions are not permitted. No nail varnish may be worn. Temporary tattoos are not permitted.
- Hair Pupils with long hair must ensure it does not impede their vision, cover their face or provide a health and safety risk. Long hair must be tied up during practical lessons, PE lessons and sporting activities.

Brightly coloured and dyed hair are not considered appropriate for school.
